

Call-for-Papers 3rd PhD Conference – July 8, 2014 Magdeburger-Informatik-Tage

"Your check mark for Doktorandentag"

At the Magdeburger-Informatik-Tage (MIT), FIN PhD students in advanced stages of their PhD present current research results. These presentations are complemented by invited talks on research areas and projects of our faculty and the university. In addition to scientific presentations, the conference focuses on giving constructive feedback to PhD students as well as on networking among PhD students.

Goal of a PhD Conference submission should be the concise presentation of the PhD research project. All submissions will be peer-reviewed – among others by the submitting PhD students themselves – in order to give constructive feedback on improvement potential. During presentations, each contribution will be discussed by a scientific committee of FIN professors. The committee assesses each written contribution, style of oral presentation and the subsequent scholarly debate. The committee will also nominate a candidate for the "Best Contribution" award. Additionally, all accepted submissions will be published in the conference proceedings (print and online with ISBN).

Submissions in pdf format must conform to the IEEE Conference Style and should not exceed eight pages. Submission is possible until (and including) May 7 May 14th, 2014 (24:00 CEST) through EasyChair. To simplify scientific evaluation of the PhD research project, each contributor is asked to also submit a list of publications in an additional pdf file. Papers must be submitted in English, while oral presentations (including their slides) may be given in either English or German.
